Scorekeeper Material

Scorekeepers must have the following material at the score booth:

- Team Scorecard Book
 - Pen/Pencil
 - Team shirt with Scorekeeper on the back
 - League Black Scorecard Book (*supplied by League*)
 - Roster Pad for Team Line Up (*supplied by League*)

Rules of Engagement

Scorekeepers must be able to do the following:

- Stay focused on the entire kickball game
 - Complete all score entries before leaving field
 - Display sportsmanlike (respectable) manner to officials, coaches and players
 - **No** alcohol and/or smoking in the score booth
 - Report discrepancies to the game managers and/or league owner – TJ
 - Line Up concerns
 - Team Name/Number issues
 - Scorekeeper book concerns (etc)

Basic Kickball Rules for Scorekeepers

Scorekeepers need to know the following basic kickball rules:

- Kicking Team can have unlimited kickers
- Outfield Team can have 9-11 Players on the field
- Five Inning per game with possible Over Time
- Three Outs for Home and Away Teams per Inning

Scorekeeper Procedures

Scorekeepers must follow the kickball procedures below:

- Be to assigned field 15 minutes before game time
 - **IN ROSTER PAD** - Record your team line up for each game (*Players must kick in the same order the entire game*)
 - Distribute team line up 10 minutes before game time - **4 copies** go to:
 - Official
 - Your Team
 - Other Team Scorekeeper
 - Yourself (Scorekeeper)
 - **IN TEAM SCORECARD BOOK** - Record scores for Home Team (front page) and Away Team (back page)
 - Record status of each kicker for Home and Away teams
 - Outs
 - Home Runs
 - Base Runs (1st, 2nd, 3rd)
 - Keep track of Player order – Name/Number on Jerseys must match Name/Number distributed on line up sheet for Home & Away teams
 - **IN LEAGUE BLACK BOOK** – Both scorekeepers for home and away team will record scores for each team
 - Both scorekeepers will sign off on Final Scores if in agreement of scores recorded.
 - If a scorekeeper has a discrepancy or concern, **DO NOT** sign and **LEAVE A NOTE** in the black book for league owner - TJ
